Introduction and Progress Report

Visit to Chosen Child Orphanage and Care Centre

- The facilities were basic but clean and well-maintained.
- The children appeared happy but in need of regular meals, education, and recreational activities.
- The staff members were dedicated and caring, providing emotional support and guidance to the children.
- The orphanage requires additional resources, including educational materials, food, recreational facilities, clothing, and bedding.

Recommendations

- Organize donations for essential items, such as clothing, bedding, and educational materials.
- Enroll some of the children in a vocational center and ensure the orphanage coordinators oversee their participation.
- Plan a visit to the orphanage before the end of the year to support the children and put smiles on their faces.

As the festive season approaches, we can provide them with the support and resources they need.
